BAPTISM INFORMATION

SIGN UP: Please visit our website at islandchristian.com/baptism to sign up and advise us how you would like your name printed on your Baptismal Certificate. **Sign up is required.**

TESTIMONY SHEET: Please complete the form as part of your registration, no later than the Tuesday before the baptism date. PLEASE NOTE: If you are getting baptized at a Thanksgiving mid-week service, you should submit your testimony the Friday before the baptism date.

BIBLE STUDY SHEET: Please print out the Bible Study Sheet. This sheet should be completed beforehand and brought to the Baptismal Class.

BAPTISM CLASS: Please be sure to bring your Bible and the completed Bible Study Sheet. The class takes place the Sunday of your baptism day and is held in the Church Library, located upstairs in the office area. If the baptism takes place mid-week the class will be held the Sunday before the baptism day.

The 9:00 am service class begins at **8:15 am** The 11:00 am service class begins at **10:15 am**.

BEACH BAPTISM: Please arrive at the beach no later than 6:15 pm. There will be a time of worship and then the baptism will take place. Please be sure to read the Baptism Attire section below.

BAPTISM ATTIRE: The church will provide you with a keepsake black t-shirt, which will be given out at the baptism class. You should also bring the following:

Please bring: 1. One or two bath towels 2. One white handkerchief 3. A plastic bag for wet towels and clothing. 4. Hair Dryer for on-site baptism (optional)

For women and girls:

Please wear modest shorts, or a one-piece bathing suit with shorts, and the keepsake baptism t-shirt.

For men and boys:

Please wear modest shorts, or a modest bathing suit, and the keepsake baptism t-shirt.
